

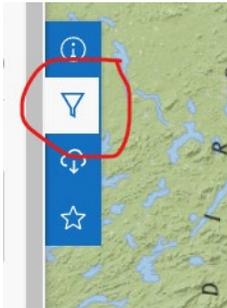
Getting KML/KMZ Parcel Data for Google Earth

To download the most current data in KML format directly from VCGI for use in Google Earth, go to this page: <https://geodata.vermont.gov/pages/parcels>


Click on Parcel Polygons under Parcel Datasets. It will take you here:

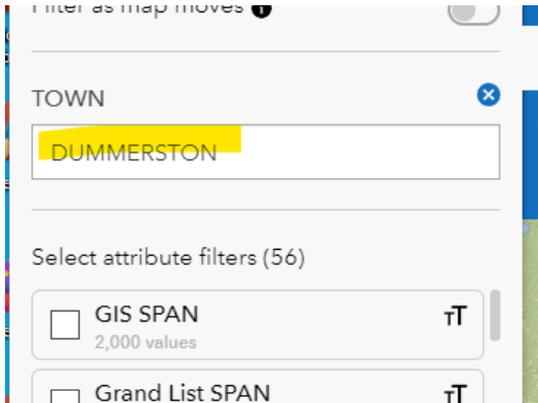
Click on the filter button to filter the statewide data to the town you want (the entire state is over a gigabyte):



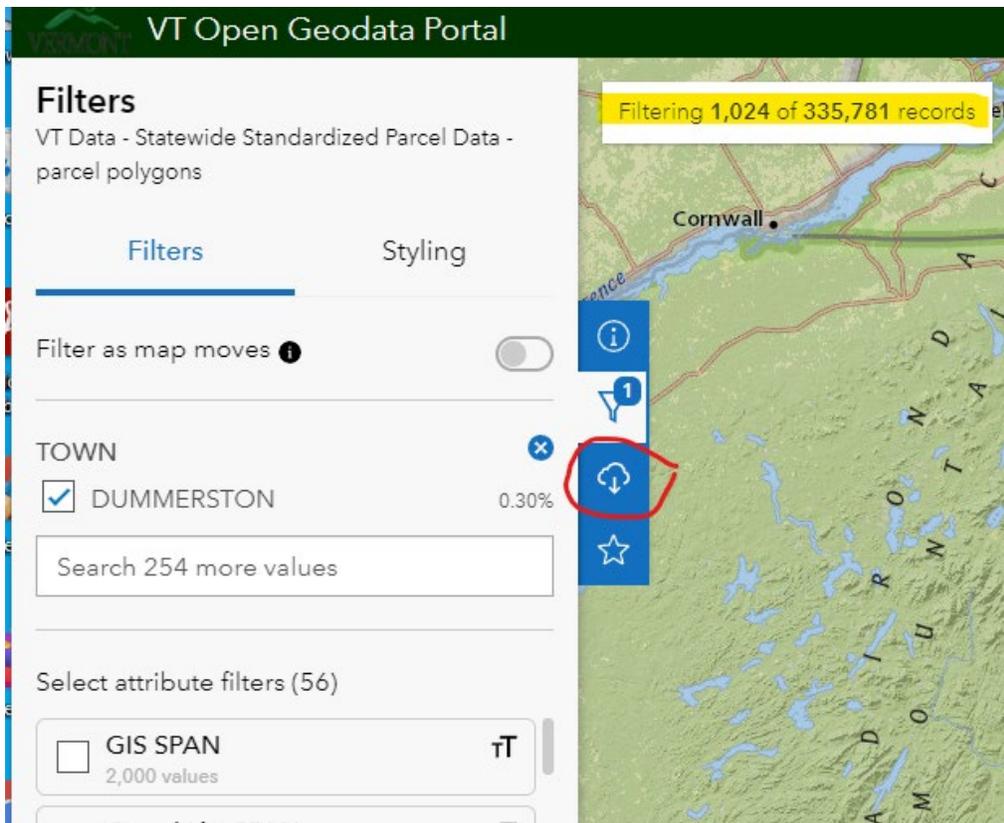
To filter by town, click on the town box on the left:




Type in the name of the town you want IN ALL CAPS in the box up top to filter for just that town (and choose the suggested town in the green box that comes up):



It'll show you it's filtered out several hundred to a couple thousand records for the town, from the 355,000 parcel records statewide. Click the download button:



Move the slider over to “Toggle Filters,” so you’re downloading just the town and not the entire state, then click Download under KML.



It will take a minute or two because it’s actually generating the KML data for you from the master statewide dataset. The file will have “statewide” in the title but that’s a misnomer.
